May 13, 2018 Seventh Sunday of Easter

Dear Members of the St. Mary's Parish Family,

Happy Mother's Day! A blessed and happy Mother's Day to the moms of St. Mary's and to all our mothers wherever they may be. A mother's love speaks to us so powerfully of God's own love - a love that is sacrificial, unstinting and always ready to forgive. The prophet Isaiah put it so beautifully when he said, "Can a mother forget her infant? Be without tenderness for the child of her womb? I tell you, even should she forget, I will never forget you." (Is 49:15)

It is no accident that the Church herself is referred to as a Mother, guiding her children in love and always ready to welcome them home. In John 14:18, Jesus promised that He would not leave us orphans, and that promise was fulfilled with the creation of His Church on Pentecost. Filled that day by the Holy Spirit of God, our Mother the Church began her long mission of raising up children in faith to know and love the Lord. "As nurslings, you shall be carried in her arms, and fondled in her lap; as a mother comforts her son, so will I comfort you." (Is 66:13)

Yesterday, the last of our three groups of St. Mary's First Communicants drew closer to Christ and their Mother the Church through the Sacrament of Eucharist. Their names are listed on the next bulletin page. Please pray for them, that meeting Jesus in Holy Communion will greatly enrich and strengthen their spiritual lives. We pray also that the experience of receiving Holy Communion each week with their loved ones will serve to bring unity and peace to their families. The family that prays together really is more likely to stay together. All of this weekend's First Communicants will be presented with certificates as they make their Second Communion at Sunday Mass. Please greet and congratulate them as we celebrate their arrival at the table of the Lord!

As you look upon our church sanctuary today, you will see the addition of our Ascension painting, placed there for the Feast of the Ascension this past Thursday. (Special thanks to the Youth Choir for their beautiful ministry at the Ascension Vigil Mass). The Ascension is a Holy Day that marks the 40th day after Easter, when Jesus Ascended to heaven before His disciples' eyes. From this point on in our Easter liturgies, the Mass preface changes from that of Easter to that of the Ascension – even though we remain in the Easter Season until next Sunday's Feast of Pentecost.

Please keep in your prayers Mr. Brian Eckert, who went home to God on Ascension Thursday morning. The brother of our Director of Religious Education, Mrs. Fran Crespi, Brian was a decorated Vietnam Veteran (a Medic), with three Purple Hearts and a Silver Star. Brian passed following many years of illness related to his military service. He died having received the Sacraments of his faith and with the loving support of his family. How beautiful for a Christian to pass on the very day that Jesus Ascended to heaven to make a place for us there. May Brian, who followed Jesus in this life, follow Him now into our Heavenly Father's Presence - there to enjoy the perfect peace, joy and consolation which only being with God can give. God bless you Brian. May flights of angels guide you to your rest.

MONEY DOWN THE TOILET ... If you attended St. Mary's last Saturday, you know that all the church and parish center bathrooms were out of order. The main drain outlet for these became clogged when someone put a diaper down a toilet. According to the sewer repair company, this joined together with a mass of flushed paper towels and feminine products to completely obstruct our whole system. It took multiple repair visits over two days to fully correct the problem. *The final bill came to \$2,099.00.* This was a totally unnecessary expense, that could have been easily avoided. So **please**, do not put paper towels, diapers, or feminine products down our toilets. Our checkbook thanks you.

CREATION CARE TEAM: This year's focus is on reducing plastic pollution. The facilitator guide to the Catholic Climate Covenant program, Beyond a Throwaway Culture, states "[f]rom contributing to land and marine pollution to increasing our use of carbon-producing fuels, our reliance on single-use plastics has had a devastating effect on God's creation. The good news is that we can solve this problem. We can all play a role in reducing plastic pollution and minimizing our contribution to what Pope Francis calls 'a throwaway culture' by working together as a community."
