**VOLUNTEER TEACHERS AND SUSTITUTE TEACHERS:** Please prayerfully consider **teaching a class** or helping as a monitor for a session this year. Teachers will be offered training and assistance from their Grade Coordinators during the year. Attending teacher meetings is required twice a year with the Grade Coordinators. Teachers attend General Sessions and events held for their grade level.

**MONITORS** are required for all class sessions. Monitors collect the attendance and record absences in the record book. They also walk around during class time to check on classes and see if teachers need anything. Monitors are asked to call families if their child is absent to make sure that they are safely at home.

**NOTICE:** All volunteers are required to complete a CORI each year, take the Protecting God's Children Workshop only once to be certified and sign a Code of Conduct agreement. Teachers must sign a Catechist Covenant that states that they will teach according to the Truths and Traditions that Jesus Christ has given to His Church.

**\*TEENS:** High school teens may teach a lower grade class if they have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Team teaching with another teen is encouraged. A letter of recommendation to the colleges of your choice will be provided by the DRE for your service to the Church.
