



SUMMER IS HERE! PLEASE CONSIDER SWITCHING TO ELECTRONIC GIVING FOR YOUR PARISH SUPPORT.

Each year, St. Mary's faces the challenge of a summer offertory drop off when people are travelling. Just as your mortgage, utility bills, etc., all still have to be paid when you are on vacation or otherwise away from home, so St. Mary's expenses still remain when you are not able to worship at your own parish on a given weekend.
