Dear St. Mary's Parents,

Most probably, you have already heard about the change of Confirmation age in our Archdiocese. The official Decree from Cardinal O'Malley came into effect on May 1, 2024. As of that date, the new age for Confirmation is Grade 8, at roughly 13 or 14 years of age. For parishes like ours with a Fall Confirmation ceremony, this means that Confirmations will eventually all take place at the start of Grade 9.

This change is the result of a study begun by our Archdiocese in 2017. The study determined that 8th graders "would benefit from receiving the grace of the sacrament at an earlier age, are less likely to have already moved away from a commitment to their faith, have closer connections to their families, and have less to preoccupy them."

Parishes were notified of this coming change last Fall, and we immediately began exploring the various forms of implementation presented to us. We were given three years to fully make the transition. I write to inform you of how this all will now unfold here at St. Mary's in the coming school year.

Next year's 10th Graders - having already completed year one of our Current Confirmation Program – will complete year two of our Current Program as scheduled. They will still be Confirmed in the Fall of 2025.

Next year's 9th Graders will enter year one of our Current Confirmation Program as scheduled. The following year they will complete year two of our Current Program. They will still be Confirmed in the Fall of 2026.

Next year's 8th Graders will join with next year's 9th Graders and enter year one of our Current Confirmation Program. The following year they will complete year two of our Current Program. They will then be Confirmed in the Fall of 2026 - a year earlier than they would previously have been.

Next year's 7th Graders will begin year one of our NEW Confirmation Program. The following year, in Grade 8, they will complete year two of our NEW Confirmation Program. They will then be Confirmed in the Fall of 2026 - two years earlier than they would previously have been.

I have enclosed a copy of the days and times that classes for the affected grades will be held starting next fall. All levels of Confirmation Preparation will involve a service hour expectation, to help our young people embrace the charity, generosity and love that are the hallmark of a Catholic Christian life. As always, weekly Sunday Mass remains the foundation of Catholic family life and religious education. To learn of the Lord in even the very best class - without the experience of the Sunday Mass to bring that knowledge alive - is a poor and watered down version of faith formation. For that reason, reflecting on each student's weekly Mass experience will be an integral part of all Confirmation Grade levels.

We will do all we can to make the new Confirmation age a blessing in the lives of our young people. And we know that you will do the same.
