

WHAT TO BRING:

- 1) **A Face Mask.** This must be worn at all times. *Children under the age of two should not wear masks. Parents should judge for children between the ages of two and five whether they should wear a mask. All people who claim an exemption because of health can forego wearing a mask.*
- 2) **Hand Sanitizer.** You will be asked to apply this as soon as you enter the church.

HOW TO ATTEND A WEEKEND MASS:

(Daily Mass is exactly the same, except that there is no preregistration or sign in upon arrival. To save cleaning, only nave seating will be used on weekdays. To allow deep cleaning, the Saturday 9 AM Mass is suspended).

- 1) Preregister to attend a specific Weekend Mass by clicking the yellow button.
Only attend if you are in good health with no symptoms of illness.

You may also preregister by calling 508-429-4427, ext. 5, no later than Noon Friday. Our capacity is now 200 seats - less if people sit alone.

- 2) Enter through the front center church doors only (or elevator if handicapped).
- 3) Sign in with the door volunteers and follow their directions exactly.
- 4) Keep 6 feet away from other congregants at all times, except your own household members with whom you may sit.
- 5) Remember there is no congregational singing, no handshake at the Sign of Peace, and no Precious Blood. Communion is in the outstretched hand only.
- 6) Please note that we are not permitted to take up the offertory collection at Mass. Kindly continue to use Automatic Giving, WeShare, or Mailed / Dropped Off Offertory Envelopes to maintain your weekly offertory support. Thank you!
- 7) The church will be emptied row by row starting from the back as soon as Mass ends. This allows time for cleaning the church for the next Mass.
